P.T.O. for general details of the Ministry of Welcome



As a member of the Ministry of Welcome within our parish family,
we seek to welcome each other to Mass on a rota basis.

There are generally two Welcomers at each Mass.

Practical aspects include:

Arriving 15min. before Mass begins.

Have Newsletters and any other special handouts ready, to hand to
fellow parishioners and visitors as they arrive.

After Mass, take a few minutes to check that the church looks tidy
for the following Mass. For example; some of the Mass books may
need to be placed neatly at points along the pews.

Co-ordinators for the Ministry of Welcome will organise the Rota
and will help guide and support you with any queries you may have,
for example, if you are unaware as to where the toilets are, or
where the wheelchair access is.

(You will need to know to give directions)

Soon you will be invited to a meeting (social and friendly) as an
opportunity for further guidance and to support each other as a
parish family and community, to experience a respectful, warm and
friendly welcome.

Ideally, we hope that all, or at least the majority of those of us who
attend Mass, will be willing to be on the rota and share in the
important Ministry of Welcome.
