Pentecost Sunday Year B 19th May 2024 Readings on Page 286 of the Parish Mass Book

Last Thursday week we celebrated the Ascension of the Lord Jesus into heaven. Today we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit on the early Church, on those who believed in the Risen Lord. Today marks the high point of our Easter celebration, the Feast of Pentecost, Pentecost means, "fifty days" after the Resurrection. This is the conclusion of the holy fifty days and marks the exaltation of Jesus and the giving of the Holy Spirit. This was also the feast day in which the Jewish people celebrated the giving of the Law on Mount Sinai. On Mount Sinai the different tribes of Israel entered into covenant with God and with one another and so became the people of God. God gave them the Ten Commandments as a guide to show them how to be a people, because being people of God means relating to God and to one another in a way that God Himself has mapped out, not in the way that we think is right. The beginning of wisdom, the beginning of true religion, therefore, is when we realize that as humans we are limited and short-sighted, and so we ask God to show us how to be the people of God that He has created us to be

Through the gift of the Holy Spirit we are brought together as one people. This universal family embracing all races and nationalities is called Church. "Catholic" means "universal." We are proud members of the Catholic Church, the Universal Church. Pentecost is not only the feast reminding us of the coming of the Holy Spirit fifty days after the Resurrection, it is also the Birthday of the Church. It is the Holy Spirit who is the driving force of the Church and every baptised Christian. The Spirit which Jesus gave as an everlasting gift to the apostles is the same Spirit at work in our present time. It is at work in all the baptised as it is at baptism that we are given the gift of the Holy Spirit. The gift which is sealed at Confirmation.

Today is, therefore, an opportunity to rededicate ourselves to be active and faithful members of this family of God we call Church. Today is a great day to ask the Holy Spirit to rekindle in each one of us the spirit of a new life and enthusiasm, the fire of God's love. **Deacon Barry**
