Parish Policy

The parish recognizes that you are the primary teachers of your children in their faith and it is our sincere desire to work alongside you and your child to prepare for $1^{\rm st}$ Reconciliation and $1^{\rm st}$ Holy Communion which are important steps in the life of your child.

Attendance

Each child must be accompanied by a parent or grandparent, not a friend of the family. It is important that families attend all sessions. You and your child are asked to plan ahead to ensure that this happens. If your child is unwell or there is a valid reason why you cannot attend please let your catechist know in advance of the session. We will provide resources for you and your child, and we ask parents to prepare at home in advance of each session.

All **follow-up home activities** should be completed as this is a vital part of the process – giving you and your child an opportunity for quiet time together with each other and with God.

For child protection purposes a register will be taken at each session and if your child misses two sessions in a term you will be asked to contact Fr Tom to discuss this.

Sessions will begin on time. We ask everyone to be punctual for all sessions in consideration of others in your group. If you arrive late, you not only disrupt the class but you may miss a vital part of the preparation.

Please support your catechists as much as possible; they give their time freely to support you and your children and this preparation course cannot be provided without their time and effort.
