Second Sunday of Advent Year B 10th December 2023 Readings on Page 85 of the Parish Mass Book

This week's gospel sees a voice crying out in the wilderness, exhorting the people to prepare a way for the Lord. This is, of course, the voice of John the Baptist, who came as a witness to the light – Our Lord Jesus Christ. But why cry out in the wilderness and not in a busy town or city, such as Jerusalem, where there are throngs of people? Perhaps the wilderness is, in a sense, calling us 'back to basics'. To escape the attractions and desires that this world bombards us with, which so frequently pollutes our minds and relegates Jesus to an insignificant figure or even try's to eradicate Him entirely.

And yet, we hear that all the people of Judea and Jerusalem made their way to John in the wilderness. What was it about John that drew crowds towards him. even the Pharisees and Sadducees? It was a deep desire to encounter God, and the people would, no doubt, have considered John as the Prophet foretold by Isaiah in our first reading today, where we hear about a voice that will cry out in the wilderness, pointing towards the coming of the promised Messiah.

So, at this busiest time of the year, where so many shops and advertisers are targeting us incessantly, we are encouraged, indeed called to make time for Jesus. To get 'back to the basics' of what really is important. A message reiterated by Peter in our second reading. reminding us to be mindful of Jesus' second coming - to try and live our lives without spot or stain.

Wherever you find yourselves this Advent, identify those areas in your lives that need to be changed in order to draw closer to Jesus. Take positive action to respond to John the Baptist's call, even if your first steps are small! And remember, there is no better time to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation as we look forward to the celebration of Jesus' birth on Christmas Day.
