We all know what happened at the Last Supper and how Peter was told that he would deny Jesus three times. This he did to three different people. He was afraid and yet as soon as he realised what he had just done Peter cried. We cry for many reasons. Peter cried because he had just betrayed his friend.

All of the disciples were overwhelmed. They saw their friend, their Lord, arrested and then crucified at the hands of the Roman authorities egged on by the crowds. They were scared and confused. It is no wonder that they were overwhelmed. We might have expected Jesus to write Peter off as being weak and cowardly and unreliable. As the team leader Peter had set a terrible example to the others.

When they meet again, on the beach, there are no recriminations or blame. Jesus made them breakfast Jesus did not write Peter off because, unlike Judas, Peter's denial was not a planned thing it was a result of weakness and not malice. Jesus, who knows us all so well, knew this.

After breakfast Jesus ask Peter, "Do you love me more than others love me?" Jesus already knew the answer and he also knew that there was another side to Peter a side that had strength. Peter had learned from his denial that he was not as brave as he thought he was, and I am sure he would always remember his denial. For the simple question from Jesus, we can all learn the simple truth that Jesus always loves us just as he always loves and trusts Peter with his work. Jesus' love brought Peter back to life because he knew he was loved in his weakness and sinfulness.

Peter had the courage to get up after his fall. He was a leader who was aware of his own weaknesses and those of others. We, like Peter, have to learn to forgive ourselves our momentary weaknesses and failures. Not to judge ourselves, or others, by momentary lapses but by our commitment over a long time to our beliefs.
