The Ordinary Time of the Liturgical year opens with the Holy Trinity Sunday. The explicit theme of this period is the theme of growth in Christian living reflecting the model of Trinity. our hearts through the Holy Spirit". St. Paul thus articulated the very nature of the Holy Trinity as perfect love shared. Later, the Nicene Creed (A.D 325) stated the doctrine of Holy Trinity more explicitly as God does not exist in solitary individualism but in a community of love and sharing.
