#### Parish Finance Committee and Parish Finances

The Parish Finance Committee supports the Parish Priest and advises him on the Parish's finances. The Committee takes a long-term view but considers opportunities and challenges as they arise and adjusts plans accordingly in partnership with the Premises Committee. The role of the Finance Committee includes sharing information on Parish finances with our Parish Community. To this end we have prepared our Annual Report and Accounts for 2024.

The accounts set out in detail our parish income and expenses. Some of the key points are:

- Our contributions did not cover our running costs. The shortfall is equivalent to 10% of our contributions.
- The increase in running costs is greater than the increase in our contributions.
- Hall lettings income makes a significant contribution to parish finances.
- Without the legacies, a generous donation of £20,000 and a Lottery grant there would have been a significant shortfall.

We expect to break even this year and in 2026 we expect to have a deficit of around £16,000. This is subject to uncertainties and assumes that there will be no major unexpected repairs. We expect to have surpluses after 2026 which will enable us to build up reserves to support Parish development.

Whenever Parish finances are mentioned, it inevitably leads to some form of appeal. This time we are asking three things:

- The closure of local bank branches makes the task of banking weekly cash offertory collections more difficult. We urge everyone to make greater use of cashless giving such as standing orders, the cashless terminals at St Joseph's Church or the Parish QR code elsewhere.
- Our gift aid tax refund is a significant source of parish income. We could recover an additional five to ten thousand pounds a year. If you pay income tax, please consider joining the Gift Aid scheme at no cost to you.
- And only if you are able, please consider increasing your weekly offerings or current standing orders.

Thank you for supporting the Parish financially. Without your contributions the Parish could not survive.
