Reflections on the Pilgrimage Walk To Aylesford Priorv 2nd - 6th June

As many of you know I recently took part in the Diocesan Pilgrimage Walk from St Georges Cathedral to Aylesford Priory, a distance of 50+ miles. Some 85 people took part in all or part of the walk, time constraints preventing some pilgrims walking every day. We were divided into five groups, I was in St George's Group, we started off with thirteen and finished with "The Magnificent 7".

I am writing this a few weeks after the walk, and have had time to digest and reflect on the experience. My first thoughts are that we were blessed with the weather. We have just had a heatwave and to be walking in 30-degree plus temperatures would not have been fun. We never had really heavy rain and when it did really pour, we were either in church or the final outdoor Mass was over - thank you God.

As we neared the end of the pilgrimage, walking in the Kent countryside, it seemed hard to believe that a few days earlier we had been dodging traffic in London as we walked from St Georges Cathedral to the Anglican Southwark Cathedral and then walking along the Thames Path. A big lesson for me at least was it is not the "I" but being tolerant of each other's foibles each of us working for and supporting each other.

My lasting feeling is one of great gratitude; gratitude to those who organised the walk, gratitude to those who offered hospitality along the way, gratitude to the strangers that we met along the way and shared stories with us and most of all gratitude to my six companions who, with me, made up "The Magnificent Seven". The pilgrimage reaffirmed that the whole is greater than the sum of the parts. We all brought something different to the walk, we shared our stories and we shared our faith and helped each other along the way. Most of all it is a feeling of gratitude to our Lord who was there with us every step of the way. No matter how heavy my burden was, and sometimes my daysack seemed to weigh a ton, it was nothing compared to the weight of the Cross that he carried for me. He gave his life for me, the least I can do is try to help others carry their cross.
