### Growing in Prayer - Christian Meditation

The practice of meditation exists in almost all the world's religions. But it is also a widespread activity among people who do not have a religious view of life. We all need to meditate, to reflect, to discover ourselves, it is a human dynamic which may help us to address the daily stress and emptiness that is everywhere. Christian forms of meditation are different from non-Christian meditation. The key difference is that Christian meditation should lead one to knowing and experiencing God in a deeper and more personal way.

In the Catholic sense, meditation is a distinct form of sustained praying. Benedictine monk John Main OSB recovered meditation for modern Christians through his study of the teachings of desert fathers and mothers, particularly the teaching of John Cassian. It is a form of mental prayer and is, 'a silent elevation and application of our mind and heart to God.' Christian meditation guided by the Holy Spirit leads to an encounter with Jesus, leads us to communion with Jesus.

In her masterpiece. The Interior Castle. St. Teresa of Avila teaches us that the soul in a state of grace can gain selfknowledge and explore the self at a deeper level. As a person meditates and progresses deep within the soul, he or she discovers Christ, the bridegroom. Catholic meditation in this context refers to a profound union with God. Padre Pio stresses the importance of meditation for growing in Spiritual life. He likens meditation to checking our reflection in a mirror: "Whoever does not meditate is like someone who never looks in the mirror before going out, doesn't bother to see if s/he is tidy, and may go out dirty without knowing it." The Catechism specifies: "Meditation engages thought, imagination, emotion and desire. This mobilization of the faculties is necessary in order to deepen our convictions of faith, prompt the conversion of our heart, and strengthen our will to follow Christ." (n. 2708).

Our Parish is offering an opportunity for us to learn and grow in using Christian meditation to grow in our prayer life. The guided Christian meditation will begin from the first week of September this year in the upper room in order to help all those who would like to use this means of prayer to experience the Lord in stillness and silence. This may also lead some of us to accept God's mercy and healing. All are welcome. **Fr. Saju**
