Twenty Sixth Sunday Year C 28th September 2025 Readings on Page 143 of the Parish Mass Book

After Henry VIII broke from the Catholic Church and established the Church of England, the Catholic Church in Saturday 27th September England faced persecution and a decline in its St Vincent de Paul influence. The Act of Supremacy declared Henry VIII the Supreme Head of the Church, and Parliament enforced his authority, making it treasonous to deny the king's supremacy. This was accompanied by the Dissolution of more than 800 Monasteries and religious houses: their wealth was confiscated and their huge role in helping the poor and sick ended. The Church's organization remained illegal in England until the Roman Catholic Relief Act of 11.00am 1829. While Catholicism continued to exist and indeed to continuously grow in numbers, it did so in secret or under the guise of other religious activities.

When Catholics in England were deprived of the normal episcopal hierarchy, their pastoral care was entrusted at first to a priest with the title of archpriest (in effect an apostolic prefect), and then, from 1623 to 1688, to one or more apostolic vicars, bishops of non-existent foreign sees, governing not in their own names, as diocesan bishops and with limited jurisdiction. All priests were itinerant; there were no parishes. At first there was a single apostolic vicar for the whole kingdom, later their number was increased to four, assigned respectively to the London District, the Midland District, the Northern District, and the Western District. The number of vicariates was doubled in 1840. becoming eight: the apostolic vicariates of the London district, the Western, Eastern, and Central districts, and the districts of Wales, Lancashire, Yorkshire, and the North.

On the 29th September 1850 Pope Pius IX, through the papal bull "Universalis Ecclesiae," recreated the Roman Catholic dioceses in England, which had been extinguished with the death of the last Marian bishop in the reign of Elizabeth I. This action restored a formal, hierarchical structure to the Catholic Church in England, leading to the creation of 13 new dioceses. Southwark was one of the original 13 dioceses. The bishops set to work to create networks of parishes and parish schools.

So tomorrow, 29th September 2025, marks the 175th Anniversary of the restoration of the English hierarchy and the formation of the Diocese of Southwark which was subsequently reduced in size and in 1965 elevated to be a Metropolitan Archdiocese. Deacon Barry
