Love explained on the Cross

On the feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross the affirmation from the Gospel passage for this Sunday is that “for God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten son that who believes in him should not perish but have eternal life”. The context of this affirmation is the accomplishment of the events from the Old Testament in Jesus Christ.

On the final day of Creation, the book of Genesis says that God said, “let us make man in our own image, after our likeness; ... So God created man in his own image, ... male and female He created them (Gen 1:26-27). The purpose of man’s creation is to have communion and companionship with God. However man and woman decided to move away from this communion and companionship, to establish a new relationship with evil by listening not to God but to the Serpent (Gen 3:5). The breach of their relationship with God brought Adam and Eve to address two compelling questions, where are you (Gen 3:9) and where is your brother (Gen 4:9). The rest of the Bible is an explanation to these two questions in order to lead all who wish to have communion with God to a renewed relationship or salvation. These two questions we constantly confront in our life; am I in the right disposition with God to walk along with God, or feel ashamed and to hide away from God? Similarly we are responsible for the care of our brothers and sisters around us. The duty of care emerges from the God given role to each one of us to acknowledge that ‘I am the keeper of my brother’ (Gen 4:9). Time and again many prophets were sent to encourage the people of Israel to repentance, but they failed. The advent of Jesus Christ opens the door to God’s love and mercy. The fullest expression of God’s love is visible in the Eucharist, in the sacrifice of Jesus which we celebrate regularly with the parish community. We honour the Cross of Jesus and reflect on the love God has for us and the price Jesus paid for our salvation. So on this feast day, the crucifix should remind us that we are forgiven sinners and, we are expected to forgive those who offend us and to ask for forgiveness through confession whenever we offend others or hurt their feelings. Today when we bless ourselves with the sign of the cross, we remind ourselves that we belong to Christ Jesus. You may keep a cross or crucifix in your room to remind you that the **CROSS** is love explained, the sign of our salvation. **Fr Saju**
