### Parish Pilgrimage to Rome& Assisi

Pope Francis on the occasion of opening the Jubilee Year 2025 based on the theme of *Pilgrims of Hope* said, "we must fan the flame of hope that has been given to us, and help everyone to gain new strength and certainty by looking to the future with an open spirit, a trusting heart and farsighted vision." Responding to this invitation, we as a parish have being making focused efforts to fan the flame of hope, among them were our pilgrimages.

It is difficult to convey the beauty and richness of the recent parish pilgrimages to Medjugorje and Rome & Assisi as I was privileged to accompany them. We carried with us the parish intentions and prayed for our parish at all the places of worship. I am grateful to all who responded to this invitation and we thank you for your prayers. Although the pilgrimage to Medjugorje is a recurring pilgrimage in the parish, this year it was specifically focused on the theme of hope visible in our Blessed Mother. Our Lady relied totally on the promises of God. What our Mother witnessed at the cross seemed to cancel out all these promises. God had promised that her Son would be called great, but now He was dying in disgrace. Our Lady trusted that God would do what He had promised. And this steadfast hope carried her safely into the joy of His resurrection. Looking at the life of Mary during this pilgrimage invoked on us grace to humble ourselves and grow in hope and be an instrument of hope in the community.

The Pilgrimage to Rome & Assisi focused on walking through all four major Basilicas in Rome (St. Paul, Maria Magiore, Latranum and St. Peter), a Papal audience and visit to the tombs of Saints Francis. Clare and Carlo Acutis in Assisi. Passing through the Holy Doors of the major Basilicas in Rome were privileged moments in life. The pilgrimage to the tomb of St. Peter through the Holy Door, holding the crucifix and praying the Psalms and prayers made this pilgrimage special and nourishing. St. Carlo who died at 15 years of age, reminded us of his saying, "Eucharist is the motorway to Heaven." The pilgrimages reminded us that it is important to be a pilgrim of hope in the church, nourished constantly by the Eucharist to share the peace of Christ. The huge number of people visiting Assisi and Rome this time will continue to reassure us that Christ lives and guides the Church in our time too. Fr Saiu
