### **Christ the King as Shepherd and Suffering Servant**

In the Liturgical Calendar of the Catholic Church, this Sunday we celebrate the last Sunday of Ordinary Time. dedicated to Christ the King. Next Sunday a new Liturgical Year begins with the First Sunday of Advent, leading up to Christmas. Through the Scripture readings for this weekend, we understand Jesus is the King to shepherd God's people and a Servant King to suffer and die for God's people. The first reading (2 Sam 5:1-3) gives us the context to Luke 1: 32-33, "The Lord God will make him a King, as his ancestor David was, and he will be the King of the descendants of Jacob forever and his Kingdom will never end." David has been anointed King over Judah and now the elders come to him to anoint David as the king over the northern tribes of Israel. The elders recall the promise of the Lord that "David would be shepherd of my people Israel." David moves from his role as a shepherd of his father's sheep to the Shepherd of the Lord's people. Jesus, the Son of David, shares this role of a good Shepherd to shepherd all God's people. The image of the shepherd has been a central expression of the Church's vision of leadership in the service of God's kingdom. Today, we who are in a role of leadership as a parent, leader, religious or priest etc, are reminded of our duty of care to share Christ's shepherding in life.

Today's Gospel passage (Luke 23: 35-43) presents to us the final moments in the earthly life of Jesus. While on the cross suffering with unbearable pain. Jesus is mocked by many bystanders. Ironically their mockery is a testimony of the saving works of Jesus during his ministry and acclaiming him as the King of the Jews, "If you are the King of the Jews, save yourself." The answer to this question is given by 'the good thief' here. The good thief responded to the blasphemy of the other thief and rebuked him saving. "Have you no fear of God? We received the same judgement, justly in our case since it is the punishment for what we did; but this man has done nothing wrong." And he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom." Jesus affirmed his recognition of his kingship and kingdom saying, "today you will be with me in paradise." Celebrating Christ the King means living under the influence of Christ to shepherd the people around us.
