3rd Sunday of Advent Year A 14th December 2025 Readings on Page 88 of the Parish Mass Book

The third Sunday of Advent is called "Gaudete Sunday" because today's Mass begins with the opening antiphon: "Gaudete in Domino semper" - "Rejoice in the Lord always." This is to remind ourselves that we are preparing for the very joyful occasion of the birth of Jesus, so we light the rose candle at the beginning of the Mass this weekend. The common theme of today's scripture readings is one of joy, the need for preparation and renewal. The prophet Isaiah in the first reading (Isa 35:1-6) gives the people who were far off in exile a promise of restoration and renewal. He reassures the people saying, "be strong, fear not God will come and save you", even though Judah had fallen short and broken the covenant, for God would remain faithful to his covenant promises. The sign of salvation is that people who are weak will experience comfort and healing, "the eyes of the blind shall be opened,... the tongue of the mute sing for joy". The expectation for the dawn of healing and salvation is visible in the Gospel today (Matt 11:2-11). Isaiah's vision of Israel's glorious future, messianic time is fulfilled unexpectedly by the coming of Jesus. This is present in Jesus' ministry, "the blind receive their sight and the lame walk, lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear, and the dead are raised up, and the poor have good news preached to them", as the fulfillment of the Messianic prophecy of Isaiah. Advent is a period of restoration and renewal of our life to experience God's presence and healing, thus to embrace Jesus into our hearts and lives

This weekend, there will be 12 people celebrating the Rite of Welcome at 5.00pm Mass as part of their preparation to be received into the Church on Easter Vigil next year in the parish. As they present themselves to God in the presence of the Parish community, they not only proclaim their willingness to continue their journey in faith, but they ask for God's grace for restoration and renewal for a new life in Christ. I request that you pray for these people who are in RCIA this year so that the Rite of Welcome during the Advent preparation will be a moment of their commitment and renewal to accept the joy and peace of Christmas. Christmas is a time of gifts both giving and receiving. Let us make sure that among the gifts we offer to others is some of the Christian joy which we ourselves have received.
